

New Technology in our Clinic Soon: Cold Light Teeth Whitening Service



We are very glad to inform you that we have introduced one advanced whitening system--The popular **BEYOND™ Professional Teeth Whitening** system which provides you with a simple, safe, convenient way to return your teeth to an optimal, natural whiteness in just 30 minutes.

The principle of operation is using the narrow beam of high-intensity blue light, combined with the whitening gel, after a special optical process removes harmful infrared and ultraviolet light, this rapidly whitens the entire surface of all 16 front teeth that restoring them to beautiful, naturally white looking teeth.

Tests proved that, **after whitening the teeth score from 5 to 10 points higher on the VITA scale.** The results depend on the teeth original color, but the result will be naturally white, shiny teeth. **The whitening could last for up to two years,** though the difference from person to person and depends on his diet and lifestyle.

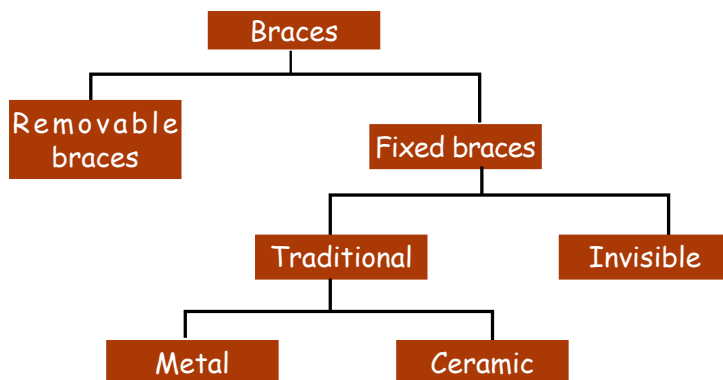


The whitening technique is absolutely safe, because it uses cold light at a low temperature, it avoids irritation of the nerves of your teeth, and the whitening fluid is water based and does not come into contact with your gums, and will not damage your teeth or tooth enamel.

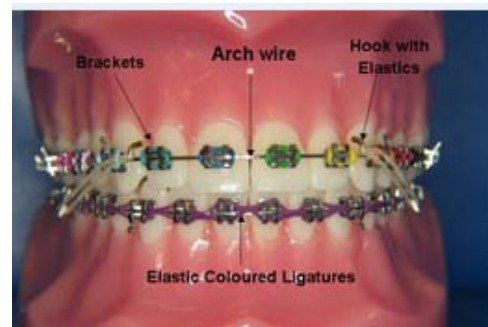
The treatment is available for anyone except for who is under the age of 16 or pregnancy. And if you have veneers, crowns, caps or fillings, we recommend that you let your dentist do some checking first as anyone with decay or gum disease is not suitable for this treatment.

For the first 24 hours after the beyond treatment, you must avoid smoking, drinking tea, coffee, cola, red wine and any other dark colorized drinks or foods. Also avoid using colorized mouthwash or colorized toothpaste.

Components of braces



Our Orthodontists System:

● Removable Braces:



Sometimes recommended for correcting a simple problem, for example moving a single tooth. The brace consists of a plastic plate with delicate wires and springs attached.

● Fixed Braces:



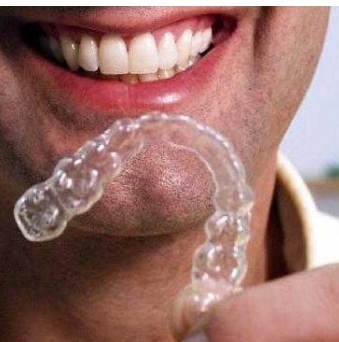
The most common type of brace. A small bracket in metal or ceramic is glued to the outer surface of each tooth, and these are then connected together by a thin wire. The wire exerts a gentle pressure on the teeth guiding them into their new position.

● Ceramic:



The clear alternative to metal braces, they are made of composite materials and the brackets are as strong as conventional metal ones. They have an attractive translucent appearance that "blends in" with your teeth and the comfortable design gives you all the self-confidence you need.

● Invisible :



Invisalign uses a series of clear aligners that are custom-moulded to fit your teeth. The virtually invisible aligners gradually reposition your teeth into the desired position. There are no metal wires or bands to irritate your mouth and best of all, most people won't notice you're in treatment. The aligners are changed every few weeks moving your teeth little by little, they are taken out to eat, drink anything other than water, brush and floss or if attending a special event. Invisalign is perfect for those who want a more inconspicuous brace and that have smaller irregularities to be corrected.
